
# How to endorse unlicensed medicines




The requirements for endorsing unlicensed specials and imports vary depending on whether the product is listed in Part VIIIB or not and how the product was sourced. Below are examples of different situations and how the products should be endorsed.

#### Endorsement details required Product listed in Part VIIIB Drug Tariff



- 'SP' should be endorsed to claim the agreed fixed fee for sourcing the product from the supplier
- 'No price endorsement needed

## Endorsement details required Product not in Part VIIIB (i.e. not in Drug Tariff)




- 'SP' should be endorsed to claim the agreed fixed fee for sourcing the product from the supplier
- Manufacturer's MHRA specials licence number MS32967
- Batch number of unlicensed medicine
- Invoice price of product ex VAT
- Volume of product dispensed

### Special Obtains

Special Obtains are those medicines that are licenced and have a price listing in the Drug Tariff. However, as it is almost impossible for distributors/wholesalers to stock every medicine or device available in the market, the sourcing and ordering of these products is not straightforward.

In most cases these "Special Obtained" licenced medicines require another account to be opened with the supplier/manufacturer. Some even ask for a copy of the prescription.

Eaststone Specials can supply these "Special Obtained" medicines and save you the trouble of investigating the supply chain of the product and the opening of unnecessary accounts.
